In his 1973 book The Alexander Principle Dr. Wilfred Barlow, husband of FM's niece Marjory Barlow, wrote that: "Alexander and some of his supporters at one time seemed to impute an almost magical significance to the "Primary Control" and some of his medical friends gave him information about "controlling centres" in the mid-brain in terms which seemed to imply a subjective awareness of such a centre, which should exert a Primary Control over the rest of the body. Shades of Descartes and his Pineal Body!"

But then I have a copy of a letter from FM to Frank Pierce Jones (given to me by Frank in 1973/4) in which FM wrote: "There really isn't a primary control as such. It becomes a something in the sphere of relativity.

From his long experience of training teachers and running postgraduate programs for teachers on four continents John Nicholls has developed an innovative step by step way of communicating the essence of what he learned from working with first generation teachers in London, particularly Walter Carrington. Vocal musculature, breathing musculature, and postural support musculature are all in a grey area between what we might call "doing" and "non-doing". They are not amenable to direct control but they can be indirectly activated and guided. FM himself is reported as saying the word " thinking" is not the ideal word for this process, and many modern psychological and spiritual teachers speak of how thinking can become a "disease".

In 1985-86 he was Chair of STAT.

He spent three years in Australia, directing the Melbourne Alexander Teacher Training School. After this he returned to the UK as Director of a teacher training course in Brighton. His book, The Alexander Technique: In Conversation with John Nicholls and Sean Carey, was published in 1991.

In 2003 John moved to New York City where he offered private lessons, "hands-on" supervision groups for teachers, a teacher certification program, and structured postgraduate courses for teachers.

In 2016 John returned to live in the United Kingdom and now travels frequently to lead seminars for the general public and post-graduate classes for teachers and consult on training courses in Britain, Austria, Belgium, Holland, Italy, Spain, Sweden, Australia, New Zealand, Brazil, and Uruguay.
